



Staff and Personnel Support (SPS) Branch- ensure that the British Army's people are ready to deploy at a moment's notice by managing its people, its finances and its information. They are soldiers first and serve alongside every Unit in the British Army; wherever the Army goes, there they are.



Educational and Training Services (ETS) Branch- provide learning and development opportunities for serving personnel wherever they are around the world. Education is vital to ensure that officers and soldiers are intellectually able to meet the roles of a modern technological army both in barracks and when deployed.

Army Legal Services (ALS) Branch- as all-Officer branch comprised of professionally qualified solicitors, barristers and Scottish advocates. The role of the ALS is the provision of legal support to the Army.



Provost Branch, consisting of:

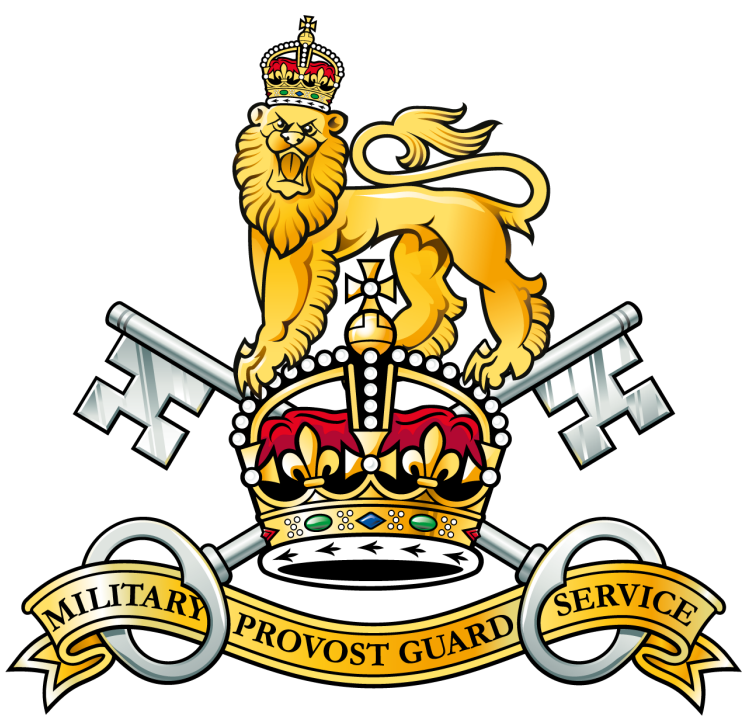


The Royal Military Police (RMP)- their core tasks are to police the Force and provide police support to the Force. The RMP deploy as part of the field army, both at home and overseas, in support of the full spectrum of conflict, conflict prevention and post conflict operations.

Military Provost Staff (MPS) Regiment- are the Armed Forces Detention Specialists providing custody and detention, advice, inspection and surety within custodial establishments. Based primarily at the Military Corrective Training Centre (MCTC) Colchester, and within Service Custody Facilities located throughout the UK and Northern Ireland. They can deploy regularly in support of operations.



Military Provost Guard Service (MPGS)- formed in 1997, provides professional soldiers to meet armed security requirements at Royal Navy, Army, Royal Air Force and other Ministry of Defence bases in Great Britain. Their primary role is to counter the terrorist threat posed to military bases in Great Britain. Their duties include: controlling entry and exit; managing control room operations; patrolling site perimeters and taking necessary action to preserve perimeter security; security incident management; and Military Working Dog services at some sites.



Gurkha Staff and Personnel Support (GSPS)- formed in 2011, providing specialist HR, Personnel and Business Administration, Finance, Accounting and ICT support to the Brigade of Gurkhas including the wider Army, during peacetime and on operations. They are soldiers first and serve alongside and administer every unit in the Brigade of Gurkhas.
